**FROM BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**

As you all know, our church building is getting older and often is in need of repair. In order to care for this building that we love, we need to make the needed repairs in a timely matter. To better address these issues, we want to make you aware of the projects that we have done and those that we still need to do. If you would like to help with any of these projects financially, please give your gifts to the Building Maintenance Fund.

\*One Air Conditioning unit behind the sanctuary was replaced in July. The cost was \$5,490.00.

\*The roof on the Educational Building was replaced. The cost was \$17,160.00. We put out a plea for help with this, and you responded quickly and generously.

\*Due to a small fire in some ductwork, we need to replace one of the Air Conditioning units in the Fellowship Hall. The estimate for this is \$7,488.50. All of these units are over 30 years old.

\*The ramp leading to our sanctuary is in need of major repairs. We want to keep it in good working order for our people who are in need of the ramp.
