did when he turned water into wine. What He did at the wedding feast is the same as He does year by year in the vineyards. What the servants poured into the jars was changed into wine by the same operation of the Master: What the clouds pour down is transformed into wine by the same master. We do not think that what happens every year in the vineyard is a miracle; we have seen it too often; yet it is really a very much greater miracle than what happened in the water jars.

When anyone really thinks of what God does in the world of nature, how He directs and controls every process, *they* cannot help but be overwhelmed by the wonder of the miracle they see. They hold a little seed in their hand- what force is latent in that little grain!

It is stupendous- terrifying.

Most *people* are so busy with other things that *they* have lost the power of seeing God in His works, and consequently the desire to worship the Creator every day. That is why God sometimes does things which are out of the ordinary course of nature. He wants *people*, heavy with sleep, to wake up and realize that HE IS THERE.
