Pastor's Letter: Now is the time.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As I sit to write this letter to you the newscasts are filled with what is nearly unthinkable– the potential for another world war. We are all praying that this will be averted and that relative peace can return. However, Russia is on the move and it appears that China may soon move against little Taiwan.

There is no need for me to list the numerous problems our society is facing within our borders– the foundations of our nation and the nations of the world are being shaken. Remember and take heart! As followers of Jesus Christ, this world is not our home– and though we are citizens of the United States, and are called to be good citizens here, the Bible assures us that our eternal citizenship is in heaven– (see Philippians 3:20), and the kingdom we are inheriting cannot be shaken or destroyed. The book of Hebrews speaks of this kingdom, and even gives us a glimpse of God's future plan, the beginnings of which we may be on the very edge.

"Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens." The words "once more" indicate the removing of what can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what cannot be shaken may remain. God will be faithful to His people. Jesus will come back for us–our call from Him is to stay faithful to Him in word and deed.
