The Divine Omniscience and Wisdom

What was your most difficult subject in school to learn? Why?

Was there a subject that just naturally came to you? How do you think that was?

IN contrast, God has never had to learn anything. No subject is more difficult or easy. He never forgets.

"To say that God is omniscient is to say that He possesses perfect knowledge and therefore he has no need to learn. But it is more; it is to say that God has never learned and cannot learn." -AW Tozer

All enigmas, all feeling, all desires, every unuttered secret, all thrones and dominions, all personalities, all things visible and invisible in heaven and earth, motions, space, time, life, death, good, evil, heaven and hell." – AW Tozer
