SERMON: Jesus is Alive! What does it mean to you?

Scriptures: Mark 16:2-7; 1 Cor. 15:1-8; Matt. 24:12-14; 1 Cor. 9:16; John 3:16-18;
1 Cor. 15:12-22; Phil 1:12-14

With no resurrection of Jesus, our faith is futile- But wonderfully Jesus has Risen from the dead! (1 Cor. 15:12-19)

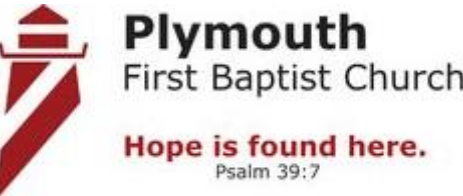
What does the Resurrection mean to you?
