## The Omnipotence of God

Psalm 62:11 "One thing God has spoken, two things I have heard. Power belongs to you God, and with you Lord is unfailing Love.

Power refers to ability, capacity, authority, might and strength. From the scriptures we learn that God is omnipotent. Meaning that he is all-powerful.

Think about those five one-word descriptors of the word "power":

ability, capacity, authority, might and strength.

How significant is power to our day-to-day living?

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When you think about it- everything concerning our existence is about this one word.

"God has power. Since God is also infinite, whatever He has must be without limit. Therefore, God has limitless power... since God is self-existent, He is the source of all the power there is." AW Tozer.

Humankind, the entire universe itself is dependent upon the power of God.

"In our society many revere the "laws of nature" ... what we see in nature is simply the path's God's power and wisdom take through the creation. Properly these are phenomena, not laws, but we call them laws by analogy with the arbitrary laws of society...

Science observes how the power of God operates, discovers as regular pattern somewhere and fixes it as a "law". The uniformity of God's activities in His creation enables the scientist to predict the course of natural phenomena. The trustworthiness of God's behavior in His world is the foundation of all scientific truth. Upon it the scientist rests his faith and from there he goes on to achieve great and useful things in such fields as those of navigation, chemistry, agriculture, and the medical arts." – AW Tozer

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“Religion, on the other hand goes back to the nature of God. It is not concerned with the footprints of God along the paths of creation, but with the One who treads those paths. AW Tozer.

So then, the biblically minded Christian should be open to believe in phenomena that do not conform to what scientists have deemed “laws of nature”. I.e., miracles.

God cannot be limited by the scientific laws determined through observation, for they are only the footprints of God that have been observed- and God is greater than man’s ability to conceive of entirely. (Rom 11:33.

Omnipotence is not the sum of all power but is an attribute of God. And God’s power is unlimited. He never diminishes in power. As a result, He does all things effortlessly. His power never needs recharged or replenished- it is infinite

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God’s power and His sovereignty go hand in hand, You cannot have one without the other.
