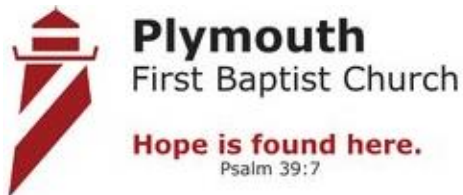
Notes:

Worship the LORD by Pastor Paul

Romans 1 states “...since the creation of the world God’s invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. ²¹ For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile, and their foolish hearts were darkened.”

We may at times forget this, but the fundamental responsibility of all creation including you and me is to worship God. Worship means to serve. We serve him by living in accordance with His laws; fundamentally loving Him and our neighbor. It is he who has created us, and we will be judged based upon our worship of HIM. It is amazing that we can wholeheartedly cheer for our favorite sports team, movie star or music artist, and yet many, even prophesying Christians, cannot show up to worship the LORD on a Sunday Morning. Or if they do, their involvement is less than it should be.

I would put forth to you today, the many problems in our world, our nation and communities are based on a failure to worship and live for God.
