#### Sermon: A People of Hope

What is hope? Hope is favorable, confident expectation having to do with the unseen and the future. The word is closely linked to faith, trust, confidence, and praise.

Psalm 62:5 \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_. Like our salvation, hope that endures can

only come from outside anything of or in this world. Hope that lasts can only come from the one who is transcendent, God.

1 Timothy 6:17

The birth of Jesus is a gift wrapped in joy, peace, righteousness, and love. Like any gift we receive, hope is that which prompts us to unwrap it.

### How can we maintain a life of hope so that we may bring hope to others?
