Tonight, we light the first four candles of the Advent Wreath- the candles of HOPE, PEACE, JOY, and LOVE. We also light the fifth candle which is the Christ Candle. As we celebrate the end of Advent and the arrival of Christ and Christmas, let us remember how our Savior came once as a lowly baby, that the world through him might be saved, and how he will one day return to rule, and reign in all HIS glory.
