Israel in the time of Jesus, experienced the convergence of 3 different cultures and laws. Roman, Greek, and Jewish. In all three, men were viewed as superior. Women had few or no rights, often viewed as property. Marriage was mancentered. Christian marriage is to not be man-centered or woman centered. It is to be Christ Centered. (Eph 5:22-30)

All Christian homes whether they have children or not are to be built upon Christ and His teachings. Children are to be trained in the ways of God. Children are to obey and honor their parents.

Biblical definition of children: those who have the capacity to know right from wrong and are still dependent on their parents.

Adult children are to honor their parents- but they are not commanded to obey.
