Some sins are obvious- some are not. The sin of dishonoring ones parents can fly under the radar of our awareness for decades and make the path following God and His ways much more difficult.

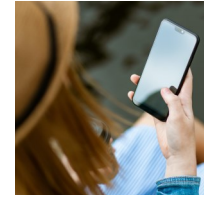
