# PLYMOUTH FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH

To the members and friends of First Baptist,

We read in 1 Corinthians 15:12-14,17-19 *"But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith... And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. <sup>18</sup> Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost. If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied."*

When Christians talk about sharing the gospel, what is called the Easter Season is at the heart of that message. The gospel message is the death, burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, and how all those who believe in Him and His work in salvation will be saved from sin and death. Because Jesus has been raised, so to will all those who believe in and follow Him.

I can remember vividly in my mind that Wednesday Evening in November 1985 when I surrendered my life to the Lord Jesus Christ and believed in his sacrificial death, burial and resurrection. I remember the lightness of my soul and the peace I enjoyed after several sleepless nights wrestling with God— wondering if I was truly saved. Do you remember when you came to such a place in your life? I was in Lynchburg Virginia. Do you have the assurance of eternal life that Jesus offers to all who believe in Him? I pray that you do. Sadly, there are people who go to church every Sunday of their lives and they never find that peace. Jesus said the following words of assurance to those who were seeking eternal life: *"And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all those he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. <sup>40</sup> For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day."*

I pray you have that assurance, if not receive Him by faith today.
