The word synagogue means: "an assembly or meeting together".

Jesus in the Synagogue:

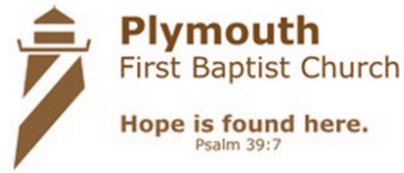
