Have you ever faced a challenge and knew that you were going to fail? Have you ever faced a challenge and in pride thought you could never fail, but then proceeded to fail? Failure is difficult- yet our Lord knows that we will fail at times- yet He has provided a process to recover.

1. Pride precedes a fall.

2. The Lord knows we will fail from time to time.

3. We at times will be "sifted like wheat." Our response is key to recovery.

4. The seriousness by which we deal with sin proves the genuineness of our faith.

5. The process of recovery and restoration begins small and grows larger.

6. Jesus desires us to not just recover but to go on to greater spiritual strength in the aftermath.
