"Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High, and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me."...The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice glorifies me; to one who orders his way rightly I will show the salvation of God!"

Psalm 50:14-15.23

Here is a reality. A person cannot offer thanks to God and complain at the same time. Often our spiritual progress is held up simply because we do not offer to our LORD praise and thanksgiving on a daily, moment by moment basis. Offering thanks to God, being appreciative for Him and what He has done in our lives and the lives of others is FUNDAMENTAL to living the life God desires us to live. Dietrich Bonhoeffer wrote, "How can God entrust great things to one who will not thankfully receive from Him all things?"

It is troubling how some Christian live as if complaining is a spiritual gift or virtue—it's not! Note the opening phrase of the above Bible verses. God offers the assurance of deliverance from trouble to the one who sacrifices thanksgiving to God and keeps their promises or vows to Him—The Most High. This names for God, is from the Hebrew El Elyon and it refers to the LORD God as the Creator of Heaven and Earth. This name points to the fact the LORD, Jehovah, is the God above all others—and singularly worthy of our praise. Just an observation, it seems that we humans are eager to praise sports figures, celebrities, people who do things for us or perform well—yet we find it difficult to spend time in praise and thanksgiving to God privately or with the body of Christ. If God's people are characterized by anything—we are to be known as thankful people. I close with the words of AW Tozer, "Gratitude is an offering precious in the sight of God, and it is one that the poorest of us can make and be not poorer but richer for having made it."
