FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH May 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

There is an important realization that every Christian needs to arrive at in order to live a transformed life- one that looks like Christ. It can only happen when we realize we can do nothing apart from the help of the Lord Jesus. In fact, when we come to a point in our desperation and say, "I am weak-I need help!" It is then that the Lord is able to do His best work in us. I must say, I see it as a warning sign when people have the attitude of "I've got my act together- I don't need any help." Proverbs 16:18 reminds us: "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall." It is our weakness that God makes us strong. The apostle Paul was dealing with a particularly difficult affliction in his body and he cried out to God for help. The Lord responded, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

We must resist the temptation to place Bible heroes on too high a level in our minds. Yes, many of them serve as example of how to live the Christian life—and we praise God for their obedience to Him. But the key to living those lives we admire is that they all came to a place of total reliance of God and his strength. Our success is found in our humility before the LORD. Let me read a few more promises about God faithfully providing the strength we need and really lean into them each day:

Psalm 46:1 - "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."

Philippians 4:13 - "I can do all this through him who gives me strength."

Psalm 28:7 - "The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in him, and he helps me."

Isaiah 41:10 - "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."
